### **World Rural Landscapes initiative**

#### **DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITY**

The *World Rural Landscape initiative* (WRLi) is framed within the activities of the International Scientific Committee on Cultural Landscapes (ISCCL ICOMOS-IFLA).

The WRLi's aim is to set an international debate on shared principles, cognitive methodologies, and adequate practices of managing rural landscapes heritage. The initiative's specific objectives are:

- Raise awareness on the need of preserving rural landscapes as bio-cultural heritage.
- Provide a space for international, public-private, and interdisciplinary cooperation.
- Support discussion and synergies at a scientific level between private and public stakeholders.
- Promote actions and share good practices of rural landscapes' conservation and management.

As part of the internship, the students will be actively involved in the following activities:

- Construction of the Atlas of World Rural Landscapes.
- Updating the current Classification of Rural Landscapes.
- Organization of meetings between international experts.

Specifically, in relation to the first two activities, students will be involved in preparing the documentation aimed at describing some rural landscape systems globally to upload on the online Atlas. The identification of new types of rural landscapes will allow the current classification system to be updated.
