breve descrizione/brief description

The workshop (which is also part of a Competition) is meant to experiment with digital audience engagement as well as to foster the envisioning of innovative and co-creative formats for the interpretation and use of European museum collections in the present scenario. These tasks will be performed by inviting creative, multi-media and multi-disciplinary explorations of the potential interplay between Open Atelier museums' contents and the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) that are at the heart of the 2030 UN Agenda.

Participants will be provided with images and specific documentation about a range of works and spaces from the collections of each Open Atelier museum (selected among those that best represent their core topics, needs, expectations or interests). Participants will be asked to develop a critical interpretation and use of these materials aimed at unfolding innovative perspectives on such works in the light of their possible connection with or involvement in the achievement of one (or multiple) SDGs.

The final submission delivery will include:

- The manipulation of digital images to produce a "graphic statement", to be accompanied by a "claim", encapsulating the proposal's meaning and message;
- a product exploiting any media, tool or format through which the statement is enabled and disseminated (e.g. an object, a digital tool, a communication or advertising campaign, an exhibit, an installation, an, exhibition concept etc.).

The initiative is meant:

- to engage with different audiences (as its digital nature will provide for a potentially global span):
- to envision and possibly experiment with different formats;
- to introduce the involved museums into the international debate revolving around sustainable plans for our future;
- to expand the outreach of the involved museums and to promote their collections and contents;
- to widen and diversify Open Atelier project's outcomes

The work of the students, together the winning entries of the Digital Competition) will be presented at Biennale di Arte di Venezia 2024 in a dedicated Biennale Session (September 2024), where the best works will be awarded with Prizes.

During the Biennale Session, students will take part in a final performative workshop run by AMAT company.

A selection of the best entries will be exhibited in the Open Atelier Museums.
