SUPPLEMENTARY FINAL EXAM REGULATIONS
FOR THE LAUREA MAGISTRALE (EQUIVALENT TO MASTER OF
SCIENCE) PROGRAMME
IN URBAN PLANNING AND POLICY DESIGN

Preamble -Sphere of application

As expressly required by article II.3.1 (Supplementary Regulations) of the *Supplementary Regulations for the Final Laurea and Laurea Magistrale Exams* at the School of Architecture, Urban Planning and Construction Engineering, this document is a supplement to these regulations and specifies and details its provisions with reference to the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) Urban Planning and Policy Design Programme.

The numbering structure of these Supplementary Regulations is thus that of the School's regulations in relation to articles which require detailing alone.

Art. II.1.2 - Laurea Magistrale study programme final exam

a) The final exam of the Urban Planning and Policy Design Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to a Master of Science) programme consists of a thesis dissertation taking the form of a volume potentially accompanied by attachments (for example maps, various format designs, audio-visual aids, etc.)

b) Thesis dissertation dimensions and time frames must be coherent with the educational credits attributed to the final exam and the official length of the laurea magistrale programme. Supervisors are responsible for this coherence.

c) Thesis dissertations are normally to be drawn up individually. Thesis dissertations drawn up by two candidates are acceptable as long as the individual contribution of each candidate is recognisable. In such cases (theses written by two students) both candidates must register and present their theses in the same laurea session. Laurea theses written by more than two candidates are not allowed.



d) the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to a Master of Science) Programme in Urban Planning and Policy Design is drawn up, presented and discussed in the final exam session in English or Italian. If a thesis is written in English it must contain an extract in Italian.

e) Admission to the final laurea exam is conditional on prior electronic thesis dissertation submission in accordance with the procedures and time frames set out by the School of Architecture, Urban Planning and Building Engineering.

Art. II.2.1 (Final Exam: presentation and discussion of thesis dissertation)

As far as the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) in Urban Planning and Policy Design is concerned, at the final laurea exam session candidates illustrate the contents of their thesis dissertations with a presentation lasting 20 minutes potentially using multi-media supports (for example Powerpoint, slide shows, etc.) followed by a discussion with the members of the Operational Board lasting 10 minutes.

At the final exam session at least two copies of the thesis dissertation must be presented to the board.
