REQUIREMENTS ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027

Requirements

You can submit your admission application if:

You have an Italian title: Bachelor's degree, Master's degree, a Bachelor's degree achieved with the old education system, or a university diploma in compliance with the requirements of the specific degree programme;

- If you're about to graduate, you must have acquired 145 credits (CFU), both for students of Politecnico di Milano and for students of other universities (degree to be obtained by the academic calendar deadline);
- You have a valid English language certification (mandatory for the assessment).

General requirements

Graduate students with a Bachelor's degree or a three-year university degree deemed eligible may also be admitted subject to assessment of their previous career and assignment of curricular integrations to fill any gaps.

For graduate students in **degree classes different than L-23**, previous career assessment may identify an educational debit to be filled prior to enrolment to Master's Degree.

Requirements CdS

Building Engineering for Sustainability - Ingegneria Edile per La Sostenibilità (LM-24)

Admission without curricular debts to all tracks of Building Engineering for Sustainability is allowed to Bachelor graduates of **L-23, L-7, L-17 class**, subject to prior career evaluation.

In all other cases, the evaluation of the candidate's previous academic career may result in curricular debts or additional requirements, even for eligible candidates

Requirements CdS

Management of Built Environment- Gestione del costruito (LM-24)

Students holding a bachelor's degree in the following classes may apply:

- L-7 Civil and Environmental Engineering
- L-8 Information Engineering
- L-9 Industrial Engineering
- L-16 Administrative and Organizational Sciences
- L-17 Architectural Sciences
- L-18 Economics and Business Management
- L-21 Territorial, Urban, Landscape, and Environmental Planning
- L-23 Building Science and Technology
- L-33 Economic Sciences

or an equivalent foreign qualification recognized by the Master's Degree Program.

Requirements CdS

Architectural Engineering (LM-24)

Admission to the Master's Degree Program in **Architectural Engineering** is subject, for all applicants, to the evaluation of the curriculum by a Committee.

Students who have a Bachelor's degree in the different classes of Engineering (with priority given to Building and Civil Engineering) and Architecture are eligible to apply. No curricular integrations are required for admitted candidates.

Requirements: English language

To access the Master's Degree Study Programmes of the Politecnico di Milano, students must demonstrate their knowledge of English language by presenting one of the language certifications recognized at a predetermined level.

The knowledge of the English language for the Master's Degree courses of the AUIC School is a prerequisite for assessment.

WARNING: Students who have not demonstrated English by the time of the application will not be evaluated.

Requirements: English language

It is possible to self-certify the knowledge of the English language at the required level and upload the certification, if already in your possession, or a certificate that proves the result of the test with the scores required at the same time as the application for admission.

After enrolment you will be contacted to submit the original language certification to the <https://www.polimi.it/en/current-students/desks-and-offices-for-students> or via the Teams platform.

The Registrar's Office reserves the right to request at any time the displaying of the original certificate in presence or distance.

There will be no automatic admission for the 2026/2027 and 2027/2028 academic years.

Candidates for admission

All candidates for admission in Master's Degree Study Programmes of School of Architecture, Urban Planning and Construction Engineering must submit the admission application online.

Students from Politecnico di Milano

- No documents should be attached to the assessment application. The previous career will be supplied to the Assessment Commissions by the Registrar's Office.

Students from other university

- Self-certification degree obtained (if graduate)
- Self-certification of exams taken and statement of the weighted average
- Other certifications of any university degree: Master, PhD, Graduate Schools.

Graduands Candidates

Undergraduates are also allowed to apply, provided they have passed examinations for at least **145 credits**.

In order to enroll you will need to graduate within the deadline set by the academic calendar.

For students enrolled in one of the Politecnico Study Programmes:

- **Students are considered graduands when they have a complete study plan (180 cfu) and has acquired at least 145 credits as effective (excluding the final exam).**

Graduands candidates

Enrolled with reserve

If you graduate after the enrolment deadline but by:

- **15/12/2026** for access to the master's degree in the **first semester** 2026/2027
- **01/04/2027** for access to the master's degree in the **second semester** 2026/2027, only if there are any seats available after the first semester intake.

you will be able to enroll in the master's degree program **under condition** (students from other Universities will be required to communicate the success of the degree)

If you obtain the title after the deadlines, your registration will be cancelled.

Students will have to respect the regular enrolment deadlines. They will be able to present the study plan normally within the time limits defined by the academic calendar.

When

Candidates for admission to Master's Degrees can enroll to the first semester, by submitting the application for admission according to the deadlines indicated by the academic calendar:

- Submission of assessment application: **22/06/2026 – 17/07/2026**
- Outcomes by: **03/09/2026**
- Enrolment by: **11/09/2026**

Any seats not allocated at the first semester intake will be available for the second semester intake.

In case of reaching the scheduled number in the first semester, it will not be possible to submit the application for admission in the second semester.

How

The application for admission must be made using the appropriate service activated on:

- www.polimi.it "ONLINE SERVICES"
- • log in with your credentials (if you need external registration)
- • select link: "Admission to the Master's Degree: application, consultation, registration"

Each candidate has the opportunity to make an application for evaluation on several Master's Degree Programmes, **up to a maximum of three**.

The student who gets more admissions, can enroll to the Degree Program that he considers appropriate.

The student can change/override their choices no later than the deadline for submission of the application for admission.

Cds and Track options (PSPA: Previously Approved Study Plan Options)

By submitting the application for admission, you will have to choose the Study Programme(CdS) and at the same time the options of track (PSPA) where required.

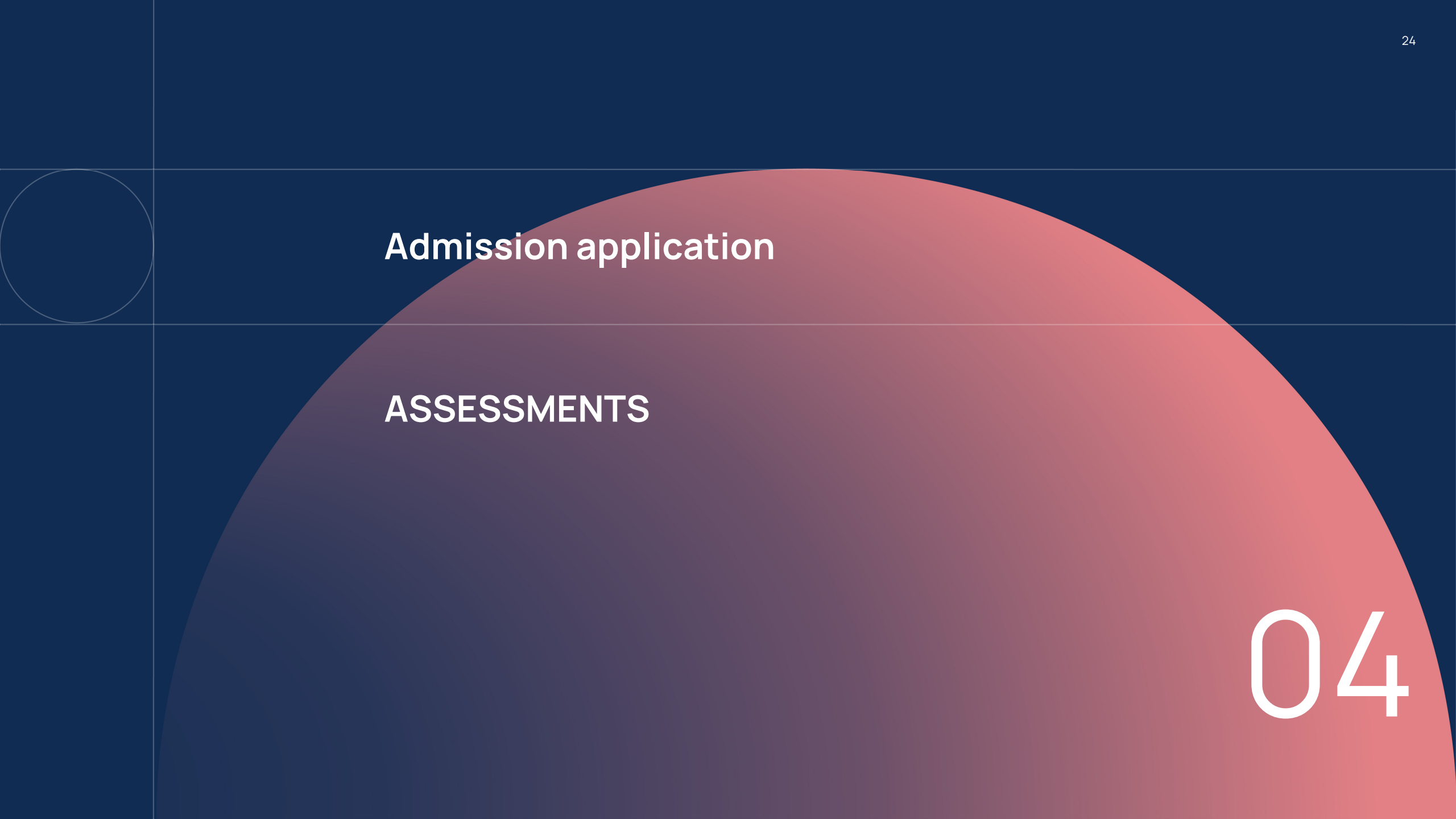

Building Engineering for Sustainability

The assessment is performed by the relevant Programme, which may award up to 100 points:

- Order of the preferences expressed at the time of application for admission: up to 10
- Duration of your Bachelor career: up to 10
- Average at the end of the Bachelor's distributed on a score of 40: up to 40
- Previous curriculum, i.e. Laurea (equivalent to Bachelor of Science) of origin: up to 40

The minimum score for admission is 62/100

Management of Built Environment

Assessment is performed by the relevant Programme, which may award up to 100 points:

- Up to 40 = Average at the end of the Bachelor's distributed on a score of 40
- Up to 30 = Previous curriculum, i.e. Laurea (equivalent to Bachelor of Science) of origin
- Up to 15 = Duration of Bachelor's career
- Up to 15 = Order of the preferences expressed at the time of application for admission

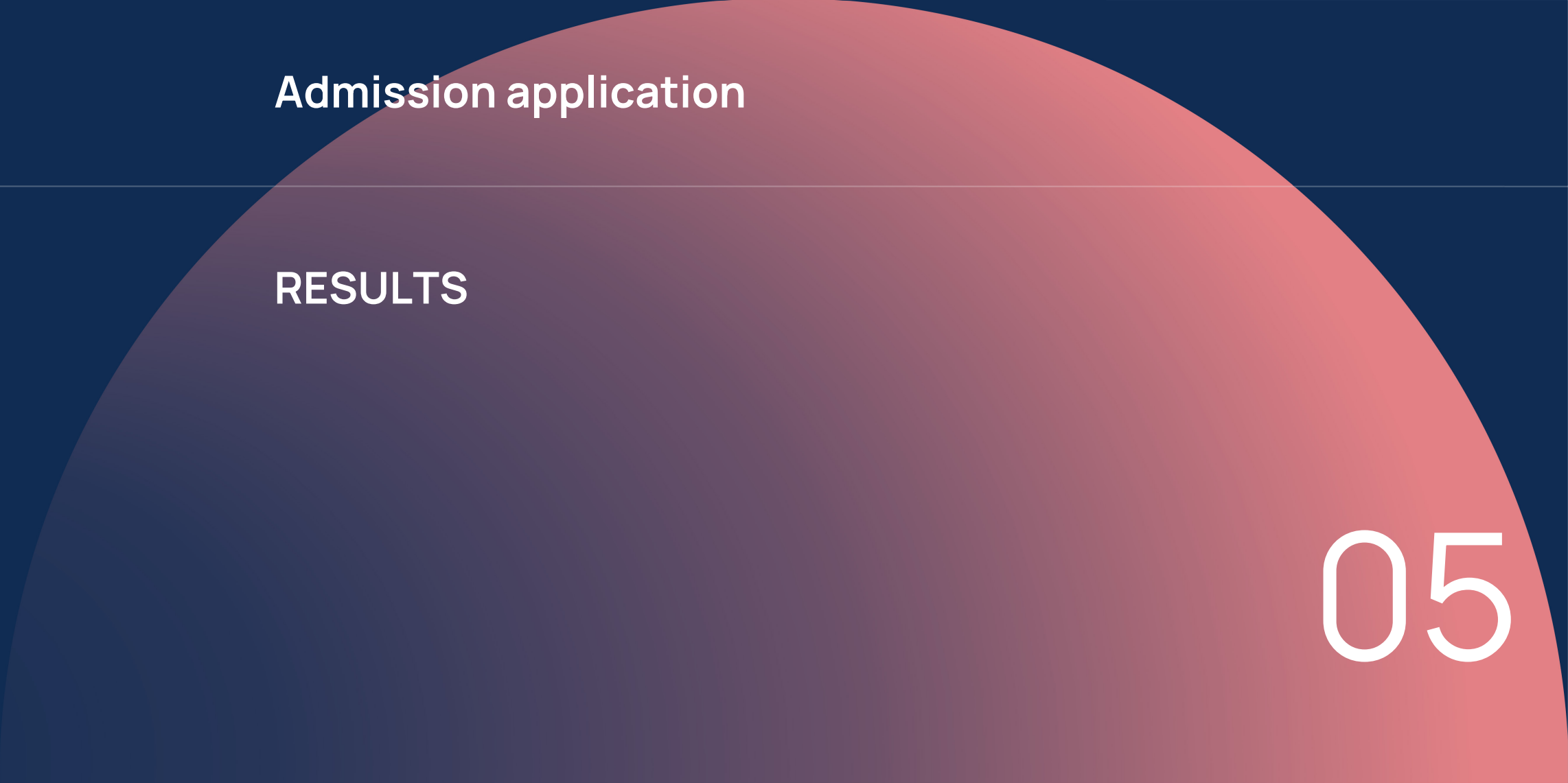
The minimum score to be insert in the ranking list of merit is 54/100

Architectural Engineering

Assessment is performed by the relevant Programme, which may award up to 100 points:

- Average at the end of the Bachelor's distributed on a score of 50: up to 50 points
- Suitability/coherence of previous curriculum, i.e. Laurea (equivalent to Bachelor of Science) of origin: up to 30 points
- Duration of the student's Bachelor career: up to 10 points
- Order of the preferences expressed at the time of the student's application for admission: up to 10 points.

The minimum score to be insert in the ranking list of merit is 65/100

Ranking and track allocation

For each Study Programme, at the end of the evaluations, a ranking of merit is drawn up according to the parameters described in the regulations to define the students admitted, guaranteeing the planned number for the academic year.

If the student has indicated, in order of preference, several choices of tracks (differentiated by language, by location or curriculum but belonging to the same Study Programme) the first choice of track expressed will be considered.

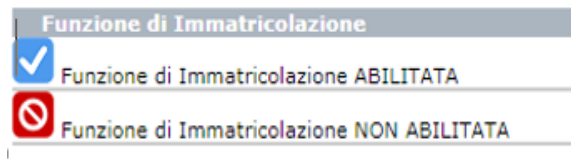
Students not admitted on the first choice of track for lack of available places, will be considered on the second choice following the scrolling of the ranking.

The tracks of the same Degree Programme, differentiated by location, provide distinct rankings.

Ranking list and enrolment

The question has been assessed positively if the check is green.

However, registration will be possible ONLY if the registration function will also be configured in ENABLED mode.



The student evaluated positively may therefore not be admitted to registration due to the depletion of the number of places available (scheduled number) according to the ranking that will be published on the School website www.auic.polimi.it by the end of the evaluations.

The outcome of the evaluation is available from the [Servizi Online](#) under the heading "Admission to the Master's Degree: application submission, consultation, outcome and enrolment".

Enrollment

To enroll you must pay the first instalment.

Access the [Servizi Online](#) and click on the link "Admission to the Master's Degree for graduate students in Italy: application submission, course passage, outcome consultation and enrolment" and enter the magnifying glass on the right of the assessment check. Press the "enroll" button and select the payment method.

Warning: from the personal page of the online services it is necessary to use the 'change matriculation' function and to select the new Master's Degree matriculation number in order to access the related services.

In case of a freshman active on single courses proceed with the withdrawal of studies for the closure of the relevant matriculation and then proceed to registration on LM.

Single Courses – Curricular supplements

Curricular supplements

You can take **individual courses** – that is, the individual modules you choose to enrol in to sit the relevant exams and earn the corresponding CFU (Additional Academic Credits) – for:

- complete **the additional coursework** required to enrol on a master's degree programme (assigned following your application for admission)
- further your personal development

Enrolment on individual courses is not permitted alongside enrolment on bachelor's degree programmes, master's degree programmes or programmes under the old system at the Politecnico di Milano or any other Italian university.

Curricular supplements

If you have been assigned additional coursework (outstanding credits), you will not be permitted to enrol on the Master's degree programme; you will see the entry "preference assessed positively with additional coursework" (purple dot).

You can fulfil these requirements by enrolling on individual courses and accepting the outcome of your application for admission to the Master's degree programme using the specific function that will appear in the details of your academic record.

You may register for a study plan comprising a maximum of 80 credits per academic year.

The maximum limit of 80 credits per year may include:

- Curricular additions assigned by the Commission during career evaluation;
- anticipation of Master's Degree Programme teachings, according to the Educational Rules, for a maximum of 32 credits per year.

Curricular supplements

Enrolment to single courses to fill curricular integrations must be within the terms of matriculation to Master's Degree given by Academic Calendar.

Students admitted with curricular integrations must fulfill them within the academic year to which the assessment relates.

If not fulfilled, one must submit a new application for admission.

Single courses

To deepen personal training

You can enroll in single courses if you want to complement training or for specific cultural interests.

You can subscribe to a maximum of 32 credits.

Master's Degrees' single courses purchased before the admission application cannot be included in the portfolio evaluation for the Study Programmes in which single courses are foreseen. They do not grant the student any access privilege.

They can only be validated if they are recognized as equivalent to active teachings in the Master's Degree Programme where the student is enrolling.

Single courses

To deepen personal training

Enrolment to single courses lasts only one academic year and allows to attend the teachings as well as taking the exams. After that, a certification can be released.

It is not possible to have two 'single courses' matriculation numbers within the same academic year.

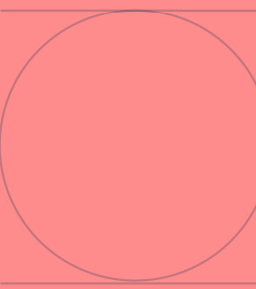
To deepen personal training

Any recognition, by the committees in charge of the evaluation of the CdS, of credits acquired may not exceed 32 credits per career to ensure the overall congruity of the study plan, and is subject:

- to having been eligible in the admission rankings for the specific CdS,
- to the possession of all the pre-requisites provided for access to the specific CdS
