# 1. TUITION FEES AND **FINANCIAL AID**

The total amount is paid in 2 installments (no further installment options are available):

- Down payment, a fixed amount of €890.04, to be paid at the beginning of the academic year (except in cases where the student is eligible for a reduction);
- Tax adjustment, an amount calculated based on your ISEEU for university purposes, or participation in the University Financial Aid call, to be paid during the second half of the academic year;

Additionally, we recommend keeping an eye on the "Scholarships and Graduation Awards" section in the Online Services, where private scholarships or those created to highlight specific interests and personal achievements often appear

## 2. EXAMS

To take an exam, you must register WITHIN THE DEADLINES through the Online Services in the Exams section > Exam Registration. Before registering, you will be asked to complete the course evaluation questionnaire. Once registered, you can also decide to cancel your exam registration. After taking the exam, the results can be viewed on the Webeep platform or through the Online Services. In both cases, you will receive an email to your Politecnico inbox.

When you decide which courses to include in your study plan, pay attention to pre-requisite or priority exams. In fact, there are some exams that, if you don't pass them, could prevent you from taking exams in later years. You can find such exams written in your Degree Programme, at the section "Pre-requisites". So, focus on these first to avoid falling behind! Here you can find the 2025/26 academic calendar with the deadlines:

# 3. STUDY PLAN

Fill out your study plan within the required deadlines. You will need to include the courses you intend to attend throughout the year, and you will have the opportunity to make changes during a time window between the end of the winter exam session and the start of lessons—but only for second-semester courses without allocation

# 4.LANGUAGE REQUISITES

OFA

If you have been assigned the OFA (Addition Education Obbligations) to enter the Politecnico, you will have some limitations when filling out your study plan from the second year onward. The Italian OFA is awarded to all internation students admitted in Architectural Design-EN. Foreign students will therefore have to demonstrate their knowledge of the Italian language before sitting the degree.

The English OFA can be passed by presenting to the Registrar's Office one of the certificates admitted by PoliMi. polimi.it/en/students/study-plan-and-ofa/ofa-additional-education-obligations-of-english-and-italian

## TOEIC

To enroll in the Master's degree program, you must have an English language certification. Pay attention to the submission deadline for this certificate because if you don't submit it on time, you won't be able to enroll. If you already have a certification, check if it is sufficient—you can do this here:
