Course of Project Management

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVE

The objective of the course is to provide participants with the fundamental knowledge and methodologies of Project Management, with reference to the international model IPMA®.

The lessons are given by professionals, specialists and managers who have managed projects in their organizations.

The training approach has been developed with the aim of transferring the project management skills through evidences, highlighting, for each module, the elements described by the IPMA standard.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT

Project management plays a central role in the vision of companies that implement projects in all economic and industrial sectors. Thanks to this discipline, it is possible to achieve objectives of efficiency and define the right relationships with all the stakeholders and the business functions that contribute to the realization of a project.

Today, the control of variables such as time/cost/quality ratio is also a central aspect in the various processes that characterize the design and the construction of architectural works.

CREDITS

The course releases 3 up to 6 credits equivalent to internship.

IPMA CERTIFICATION

At the end of the course, on a voluntary basis, enrolled students can take the certification exam in project management in order to obtain the “*Introductory Level in Project Management*” certification issued by IPMA Italy, on payment of € 100 + IVA (TBD – to be defined).

LANGUAGE

The course will be held in English.

EXAMINATION ARRANGEMENTS

In order to pass the course and get the required credits it is necessary to:

- be present at least to 75% of the classes;
- submit, in groups, a project work;
- pass the final test consisting of 30 multiple choice questions. More information will be provided in the next future.
