SUPPLEMENTARY FINAL EXAM REGULATIONS
FOR THE THREE YEAR LAUREA (EQUIVALENT TO BACHELOR OF
SCIENCE) PROGRAMME
IN URBAN PLANNING: CITY, ENVIRONMENT, LANDSCAPE

Preamble -Sphere of application

As expressly required by article II.3.1 (Supplementary Regulations) of the *Supplementary Regulations for the Final Laurea and Laurea Magistrale Exams* at the School of Architecture, Urban Planning and Construction Engineering, this document is a supplement to these regulations and specifies and details its provisions with reference to the Laurea (Equivalent to Bachelor of Science) Programme in Urban Planning: City Environment Landscape.

The numbering structure of these Supplementary Regulations is thus that of the School's regulations in relation to articles which require detailing alone.

Art. II.1.1 (Type of Final Graduation Exam)

a) The final exam for the laurea (equivalent to Bachelor of Science) programme in Urban Planning: City Environment Landscape consists in a thesis dissertation (type A Final Exam) taking the form of a volume, potentially with attachments (such as, for example, maps, designs in various formats, audio-visual supplements, etc.).

For the Urban Planning: City Environment Landscape Laurea programme the type B Final Exam option (final results of specific activities carried out by the undergraduate in the course of his or her studies) is not available.

b) Thesis dissertation dimensions and time frames must be coherent with the educational credits attributed to the final exam and the official length of the Laurea programme. Supervisors are responsible for this coherence.

c) Thesis dissertations are normally to be drawn up individually. Thesis dissertations drawn up by two candidates are acceptable as long as the individual contribution of each candidate is recognisable. In such cases (theses written by two students) both candidates must register and present their theses in the same Laurea session. Laurea theses written by more than two candidates are not allowed.

d) Thesis dissertations are to be written and presented in final exam session in Italian or English. If a thesis is written in English it must contain an extract in Italian.

e) Three year laurea thesis dissertations are not subject to registration.

Art. II.2.1 (Final Exam: presentation and discussion of thesis dissertation)

As far as the Urban Planning: City Environment Landscape laurea programme is concerned, at the final graduation exam candidates must illustrate the contents of their thesis

dissertations with a presentation lasting 15 minutes including with the support of multi-media tools such as PowerPoint, slide-shows, etc.

Presentations can take a further 5 minutes of replies to any questions made by the members of the Operational Board.

At the final exam session at least two copies of the thesis dissertation must be presented to the board.
