Call for applications

Call for applications for a paid internship **“Renzo Piano” A.Y. 2021-2022**

Art.2

Participation requirements

The call for applications is open to students of Politecnico di Milano enrolled in the 2021-2022 academic year in the second year of a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) or fifth year of a single-cycle Laurea belonging to the LM24 (Laurea Magistrale in BUILDING SYSTEMS ENGINEERING) or LM4 (Laurea Magistrale in ARCHITECTURE AND ARCHITECTURAL ENGINEERING) as part of the **School of Architecture, Urban Planning Construction Engineering** programmes who, on the applications closing date have acquired:

- at least 52 ECTS if enrolled in the second year of a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programme;
- at least 200 ECTS if enrolled in the fifth year of a single-cycle Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programme.

A student appointed by the University and meeting the selection criteria identified by the professors in charge must know the computer programmes used by Renzo Piano Building Workshop srl, particularly Revit, Photoshop and Rhinoceros, in addition, they must have a good knowledge of the English language and good manual skills in creating study models and hand drawing.

The internship will take place at Renzo Piano Building Workshop srl, registered office in Genova Via P.P. Rubens n.29, for six months (from 7 February 2022 to 5 August 2022) and may be validated as a compulsory curricular internship, after a student makes a request to the School and under the School regulations.

The Renzo Piano Building Workshop srl guarantees to the candidate the direct payment of a gross indemnity of € 7.200,00.

The amount will be paid directly to the student through monthly payments of € 1.200,00.

(not paid for periods of internship suspension of a minimum duration of 15 calendar days).

Accommodation will be made available free of charge or any travel expenses will be reimbursed and a Ticket Restaurant will be provided for an amount equal to € 7.00 per day (Monday to Friday excluding holidays).

Given the pandemic emergency, should it be necessary to suspend the internship, it will be possible to recover it immediately following the internship original end date or when the health situation makes it possible.

If during an exceptional suspension period, the trainee obtains a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) and loses their student status, it will not be possible to recover the suspension period except by formalising a post-graduate internship (subject to the regulations on extracurricular internships, as per <Regional Council Decree 17 January 2018 no. X/7763), through the Politecnico di Milano Career Service office.

Art.3

Application for admission and submission deadline

Applicants must apply using the Online Services: <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> [Benefits and Agreements > Economic benefits] **by 12 noon (Italian time) on 8 November 2021.**

Under penalty of exclusion, the applicant must attach the following mandatory documents in pdf format (maximum 10 MB) to the application form:

1. curriculum vitae, accompanied by any English knowledge certificates;
2. portfolio, of the best works developed during the training course in A4 format;
3. Motivational letter.

Files must be named with Surname-First Name-Documents Type.pdf (for example, Rossi-Mario-Curriculum.pdf)

The completion of the online application is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents.

It is the Applicant's responsibility to verify the correct conclusion of the process.

Failure to complete and submit the application or submitting an incomplete application will result in the student being excluded from assessment.

Selection Committee

The Selection Committee is appointed by the School of Architecture, Urban Planning Construction Engineering and consists of at least three School full or associate professors.

Applicant qualifications and assessment criteria

An initial assessment will be based on the documents listed above and the average and the number of credits registered at the date of the call deadline.

The Selection Committee has 150 points available, distributed as follows:

Assessment of the professional educational curriculum (weighted average of exam scores based on at least 52/200 credits acquired). The average of the examinations recorded in the syllabus at the time of assessment will be considered	up to 110 points
Assessment of a portfolio of works including texts and iconographic material, based on content originality and formal quality, argumentative and graphic capacity, and linguistic expression	up to 20 points
Assessment of the curriculum vitae	up to 5 points
Assessment of the motivational letter	up to 5 points
*Motivational interview	up to 10 points

***The first 10 students in the ranking list will move on to the second stage of the selection, which will be based on the outcome of an individual interview and will be notified by an email sent to the institutional email address.**

Art.6

Selection interview

The interview will be held on **3 December 2021 at 10 am** - on line - Teams platform, the link will be provided in the interview email.

To be admitted to the interview, applicants must have one of the following valid identification documents: identity card, passport or driving licence.

Failure to attend the interview on the date and time set or late participation, even if due to force majeure, will be considered as a waiver of participation in the selection.

Art.7

Merit ranking

The Committee draws up a merit ranking list. If there are equal scores, the youngest applicant in the ranking is given precedence.

There is no “next ranking” list mechanism
